- Q: What are my voting rights in the condominium association?
- A: The owner of each condominium unit shall be entitled to cast one vote per unit as provided for in Article VI of the Declarations.
- Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on my right to use my unit?
- A: Each unit is restricted to no more than six (6) occupants. Refer to the Declaration, Article X page 20, Use Restrictions.
- Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium document on the leasing of my unit?
- A: The minimum rental period is ninety (90) days, and the maximum rental period is unrestricted.

 One lessee and members of immediate family and guests. No individual room rentals or transient tenants. No time sharing. No subletting. See Use Restrictions, Article X of the Declarations.
- Q: How much are my assessments to the condominium association for my unit type and when are they due?
- A: For the year 2025, the monthly dues are \$1,330.00. Monthly dues are due on the first day of each month. This amount is subject to change based upon budget requirements.
- Q: Do I have to be a member in any other association? If so, what is the name of the association and what are my voting rights in the association? Also, how much are my assessments?
- A: No. There are no other associations related to The Meridian.
- Q: Am I required to pay rent or land use fees for recreational or other commonly used facilities? If so, how much am I obligated to pay annually?
- A: No
- Q: Is the condominium association or other mandatory membership association involved in any court cases in which it may face liability in excess of \$100,000? If so, identify each such case.
- A: No
- Q: Is the condominium created within a portion of a building or within a multiple parcel building?
